Calendar Year 2023 Report on the Utilization of Breast Cancer Research and Education Funds

State Finance Law § 97-yy requires the New York State Department of Health (Department) to submit an annual report to the Legislature, the State Comptroller and the public regarding how the monies of the Breast Cancer Research and Education Fund (Fund) were utilized during the preceding calendar year. The statute specifically requires the Department to report on the following five items:

- i. The amount of money disbursed from the Fund;
- ii. Recipients of awards from the Fund;
- iii. The amount awarded to each recipient;
- iv. The purposes for which such awards were granted; and
- v. A summary financial plan for the current and succeeding fiscal years.

The enclosed table represents a snapshot of each of these requirements.

A total of \$1,623,426 was disbursed during calendar year 2023 to sixteen (16) breast cancer research contractors: one (1) was awarded funding through the "Peter T. Rowley (Round 3)" RFA, two (2) were awarded funding through the "Healthcare Practitioner Breast Cancer Education Research Projects (Round 2), one (1) was awarded funding through the "Peter T. Due to the HRSB being unable to meet quorum requirements to hold a meeting to vote on applications, the Department utilized its rights and withdrew the application. No applications were received in response to the Healthcare Practitioner Breast Cancer Research Education Education Projects (Round 5).
